

Lexington Public Schools Clubs and Organizations Annual Notification Policy

Lexington Public Schools will notify parents/guardians in writing about any clubs or organizations sponsored by or under the direction and control of the school. The notification will be published in the student handbook and will be posted on the Lexington Public Schools Website, www.lexington.k12.ok.us. The annual notification will include the name of the club or organization, the mission and/or purpose of the club or organization, and the name of the advisor/sponsor, if known.

If any club or organization is created or formed after the annual notification is distributed, Lexington Public Schools will send additional notification to the parents/guardians with information about the additional club or organization.

Parents or guardians of students will have the opportunity to notify school administration in writing if they do not wish for their student to join or participate in one or more clubs or organizations. The written notification shall only apply to participation in clubs and organizations that are extracurricular and shall not apply to participation in clubs and organizations that are necessary for a required class of instruction.

It is the parents' or guardians' responsibility to prevent their student from participating in a club or organization in which permission is withheld. Parents or guardians will also be responsible for retrieving their student from attendance at a club or organization in which permission is withheld.

The board of education of Lexington Public Schools shall have full power and authority to regulate, control, or prohibit any club or group.
