RE: Public Events

Lexington Public Schools, recognizing that upcoming competitions and performances are scheduled for indoor facilities, and that indoor facilities create an environment where the risks related to covid-19 are elevated, will require facial coverings for all indoor events open to the public until further notice.

Competition Gym: A facial covering is required. As we are not in this alone, schools that we regularly compete with are requiring similar measures. Seating will be limited through November 30th or any other time that facial covering requirements become difficult to enforce.

School Auditorium: A facial covering is required. As you know the school's auditorium is not large. We will work to separate performances into as specific groups as possible. Seating will only be limited when it becomes difficult to enforce facial covering requirements.

*Gyms and training rooms open to Little League sports should follow the same facial covering requirements for any person in our facilities that is not practicing or competing. Temperatures of Little League athletes should be monitored similar to school athletes.
