IF YOU ARE AN ATHLETE AND INTEND TO PLAY SPORTS IN COLLEGE, MAKE SURE YOU SIGN UP FOR NCAA BY VISITING WWW.NCAA.ORG. You click on "Eligibility Center" and create a Prospective Student Athlete Account by clicking on "U.S. STUDENTS REGISTER HERE". You will need to pay a registration fee. If you take the ACT, NCAA requires that they receive your scores directly from ACT. When you register, you must enter code 9999 for ACT to send scores.

Begin to apply to your individual colleges of interest NOW! If you meet admission criteria, NOW IS THE TIME! The earlier you apply for admission, the better your chances of getting scholarships and offers. Just because you apply to a college and they accept you and offer a scholarship, does not mean you are obligated to go there. SHOP around, apply to colleges and determine later where your best offers and programs are.

I will be able to offer 2 days of “excused absences” for you to visit college campuses. See me for more information.

FAFSA became available in OCTOBER. You will use your tax information from this past April to complete the application. The earlier you apply for FAFSA, the better. All colleges will require that you apply for FAFSA whether or not you are eligible. This will be done at www.fafsa.gov. Everyone who will go to college will be required to fill out a FAFSA application.

The application deadline is November 15th.

However, we anticipate that a majority of scholarship recipients will be eligible to receive a Pell grant.

The Hagan Scholarship Foundation

The Hagan Scholarship is a nationwide, need based merit scholarship for rural students who will require financial assistance to attend college. These students will graduate from a public high school located in a county in the United States having fewer than 50,000 residents. Three hundred fifty scholarships can be awarded each year. Eligibility: (1) Must be a U.S. Citizen. (2) Must attend an Eligible Public High School; see List of Eligible Public High Schools. (3) Must be a student in the 2018 high school graduating class. (4) Must have achieved a high school CGPA of 3.50 or higher. (5) Must have scored 23 or higher on the ACT (Composite Score); or 1,200 on the SAT. (6) Must enroll in a four-year college the first semester following high school graduation. (7) Must work 240 hours in the twelve months prior to the start of college. (8) Must complete the FAFSA in 2017 using 2016 tax return information.

FAFSA EFC must be less than \$6,500. (9) Must apply for eligible Federal and State grants. (10) Must not have been convicted of a felony.

The amount of each Kids' Chance of Oklahoma, Inc. scholarship award is decided by the Scholarship Committee and Board of Directors. The award will be paid directly to the education institution. The award is contingent upon available funds.

Goddard Memorial Dinner. (6) The applicant may apply for any of the scholarships offered by the National Space Club and Foundation (Robert H. Goddard Memorial Scholarship, Olin E Teague Scholarship, Keynote Scholarship) in the same year, but may only win one in the same year.
