Parents and Athletes:

We will be hosting our physicals on August 6th beginning at 7:00 pm. The cost of the physical will be \$15 with proceeds going to Lexington Athletics to assist with funding all our athletic programs. There are a number of forms that each athlete must have on file with a parent's signature to begin any athletic program at Lexington Public Schools. Each athlete must have a signed physical form, signed concussion sheet, signed sudden cardiac arrest information sheet, and signed insurance form. All of these forms are available on the athletics page of the school's website: www.lexington.k12.ok.us. These forms will also be available to pick up in the high school office if necessary.

All athletes 6-12 must have all forms signed by a parent on file before they may begin any activity, including practice, at Lexington. For the best results, if a parent would accompany the athlete to the physical exam, all the forms can be filled out and signed without ever leaving the facility. We have had a number of physicals not returned last year since they had to be taken home to have a parent sign.

All athletes 8-12 must complete a drug screening before they will be allowed to compete in any sport. The athletes are also subject to be selected for any of 3 random screenings throughout the school year. The cost of the initial screening is \$25, and this fee **WILL BE COLLECTED AT ENROLLMENT**. Checks may be made payable to Lexington Public Schools. A date for drug screening will be announced soon.

We, as an athletic staff, are excited about the opportunities as well as have high expectations for the upcoming school year.
